5G-ACIA's remit is:

To apply 5G in the industrial domain. In the best way possible.

- The fourth stage of the industrial revolution, also known as smart manufacturing, heralds an entirely new era. Its goal is to significantly improve the flexibility, versatility, usability and efficiency of production systems and to make the vision of smart factories come true. In this context, wireless communication – in particular 5G – is a key enabler. It provides powerful and pervasive communication between machines, people and objects.
- Workshop attendees will learn how 5G-ACIA is working to influence 5G capabilities in order to better support industrial automation use cases and to effectively meet the needs of discrete and process manufacturing – including 5G integration, testing and validation.

The midlands has a rich heritage of manufacturing generating 20% of UKs manufacturing GVA. Using 5G to accelerate adoption of Industry 4.0 technologies has huge potential to increase productivity and growth. The scope of this event aligns well with the ambitions of WM5G and many of the manufacturing organisations in our region.
